DAY 1 Tuesday 7 May : Welcome to Italy (D)

Today we all meet at the Hotel Aleph in Rome. At 11am we will board our private minibus and depart on a leisurely 3 hour drive through regional Italy to Ponte a Bozzone, the small town where our Villa is located.

On arrival at the villa, Wendy and Lyn will be waiting to welcome you to your home for the next 5 nights, Villa Matilde. You will have the afternoon at your leisure to settle in to your room and enjoy all that this villa has to offer. Lyn and Wendy will host a special dinner to welcome new friends and to discuss the upcoming days whilst in Tuscany.

DAY 2 Wednesday 8 May : Siena (B)

A continental breakfast is waiting for you in our kitchen this morning. Come down when you are ready as our first day will be spent in Siena, just a short drive from our Villa. We will be departing at 11.00am for our city tour. Siena is a charming medieval town surrounded by 14th Century walls. We will be taking a 4 hour walking tour, with some free time for some shopping. Meet us later this evening as we dine at a local restaurant and taste the wonderful delicacies of this region.

DAY 3 Thursday 9 May : San Gimignano, Monteriggioni and Volterra (B&D)

We have a full day ahead of us. After an early morning breakfast at our villa, we will make our way towards today's destinations, San Gimignano, Monteriggioni and Volterra, three beautiful towns in Tuscany. San Gimignano began its life as a town in the 10th century. Its towers date back to the 11th and 13th centuries. Afterwards we will continue towards the tiny but beautiful town of Monteriggioni with its walls and remaining towers. Due to the type of its fortification, Monteriggioni remained an invincible fortress for three centuries. After lunch (at your own cost), our journey will continue to our last destination, Volterra, one of the finest and lesser known hilltop towns tucked away in the heart of Tuscany. We will return to our villa approx. 6pm where a light dinner will be served.

DAY 4 Friday 10 May : Winery Visit (B&D)

Today we will enjoy a unique experience: lunch and wine tasting in the heart of the Tuscan region. Departing from our Villa, we will head south towards Greve in Chianti where we will make our way to Villa Vignamaggio or Castello di Verrazzano. Here we will enjoy a guided tour of the cellars followed by a delicious lunch and wine tasting. Your sommelier will make this a very unique experience, giving you some secrets about wine to share with family and friends. If you are still peckish, tonight a light dinner will be served at the Villa.

DAY 5 Saturday 11 May : Your Choice (B&D)

Today you can choose between a Bike Tour, a Full Day Tour to Cinque Terre or a Cooking Class.

Those of you joining us on the bike tour, we will be discovering the beautiful area of Chianti! During our ride we will enjoy a visit to a castle before enjoying a wonderful Picnic in this amazing area of Tuscany. In the afternoon our tour will continue through the hills of Chianti before going back to the Villa.

For those of you who have not visited Cinque Terre, this can be arranged for you today. It will be a long day, 13 hours, but oh so worth it.

Wanting to learn how to make pasta the Italian way? We invite a local chef to our villa this afternoon to show us the secrets to making this famous Italian cuisine.

Join us tonight for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 6 Sunday 12 May : Tuscany to Florence (B)

After breakfast we say farewell to our Villa and spend the night in Florence. Florence, the capital of the Tuscan Region, is home to many masterpieces of Renaissance Art and Architecture. Enjoy the afternoon wandering the Uffizi Gallery at your own leisure or join Wendy and Lyn for an afternoon of shopping.

DAY 7 Monday 13 May : Florence to Naples (B)

This morning after a leisurely breakfast at our hotel, we board a train to Naples, where our Luxury Ponant ship is awaiting our arrival.

The next 8 days are going to be pure luxury, if you haven't had enough already! Check in to your Deluxe Stateroom on board the Le Lyrial Yacht. Meet us up on the deck for drinks as we set sail and say Arrivederci Naples and Ciao to Sicily.



DAY 8 Tuesday 14 May : Taormina, Sicily

Located on Sicily's eastern coast, in the province of Messina, the seaside town of Taormina is Sicily's Saint-Tropez, boasting heritage sites, secluded beaches and luxury shopping. You can visit its medieval centre, suspended 300 metres above sea level, where terraces offer a spectacular view of the Mediterranean Sea. Another vestige from its past are the ruins of the Greco-Roman theatre. This extremely well-preserved site attracts visitors who are fascinated by the natural beauty of the area which overlooks a turquoise bay

DAY 9 Wednesday 15 May : Otranto

Located in the Apulia region, Otranto is the easternmost transalpine town. Behind its medieval ramparts, you will taste the sweet life of Salento, the "heel on Italy's boot". Inhabited since Antiquity, Otranto has today become a very pleasant seaside town. Yet its history is still visible as you meander through the little streets of its old centre. With its magnificent 12th century ornamental mosaic tiling, the Cathedral is one of its most beautiful treasures. During a stroll along the ramparts, you can sit and relax at a café terrace.

DAY 10 Thursday 16 May : Kotor

Situated in one of Montenegro's most beautiful bays, the medieval city of Kotor is a small town full of charm, truly imbued with the traditions and stories of another time. Built between the 12th and 14th centuries, this village, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, has preserved many historical monuments from this epoch. During your stop, be sure to admire the impressive castle that dominates the town, and let yourself fall under the charm of its maze of small streets and intimate squares on which folk festivals featuring magnificent colourful costumes are often organised.

DAY 11 Friday 17 May : Dubrovnik

Emblem of the Dalmatian coast, Dubrovnik is magnificently positioned on a rocky spur. History is sovereign here, in this ancient city, now a listed UNESCO World Heritage site. You will perhaps be surprised by the proportions of La Placa, the central drag through the city. The sheer width of it can be explained by the fact that it straddles a former lagoon. The elegant houses along La Placa are built in the legendary

travertine stone. At Pile gate, you will be greeted by the statue of the patron saint of Dubrovnik, and you can admire the coastline as you walk along the ramparts. But what's inside Fort Saint John, adjoining the outer walls? A maritime museum and an aquarium featuring rare fish from the Adriatic.

DAY 12 Saturday 18 May : Split

On the Dalmatian coast, the town of Split offers cultural visits in a seaside atmosphere. Close to the seafront shaded by palm trees, the historical centre listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site, boasts a unique building: the Diocletian's Palace. Here you will explore its galleries, courtyards with carved columns, as well as a former mausoleum converted into a church, namely Saint Domnius Cathedral. If you get peckish, stop off at a terrace in the Pjaca, the main square in the old town, where you can try a palacinka, a kind of pancake topped with melted cheese.

DAY 13 Sunday 19 May : Piran

On the Slovenian coast, the picturesque town of Piran stands on a tongue of land bathed by the Adriatic. Its old town, girded by fortifications, provides a medieval atmosphere embossed with Venetian nuances. From Tartini square, you can explore a whole interweave of mysterious streets located on the hillside, leading you to Saint George's church, built on a hillock overlooking the shoreline. After admiring the view, don't miss a good look at the nave, and its rich decorations of frescoes and panelling. You will also see that the tower built behind the church reproduces the famous bell-tower of Saint Mark's square. During your peregrinations, make sure you try a borek, a sort of pastry which can be sweet or savoury, filled with meat or fruit.

DAY 14 Monday 20 May : Venice

This morning we disembark our Ponant ship and come to the end of our adventure together, in the beautiful town of Venice. Say Goodbye to Wendy and Lyn and all of your new friends. A transfer to the airport can be organised for those returning home today.
